**Rehearsals:**

We will hold 2 rehearsals to put the show together. Please check the cover page to determine the dates and times. Check the posted show order to find out which act your child will be performing in. (will be posted by June 1st)

**Rehearsal Fee:**

Every year we include a rehearsal fee with the costume payment. This fee is \$25.00 for each student, regardless of the number of dances they perform in. The fee will include a 2010 Recital T-shirt (an \$18 value). Please provide the desired T-shirt size on your contract which you submit with your costume payment before February 8<sup>th</sup>.

**Costumes:**

Every class will have a picture of the class costume and the price posted in the dance hall. Costume payment must be remitted no later than Monday February 8<sup>th</sup>. Check your costume information and remit payment with your rehearsal fee to the front desk. We will not order a costume until it is paid in full. If you are late in paying for your costume, there is an extra rush shipping charge. If you remit payment too late you are at risk of not being able to get the costume in time for the recital. Payment for costumes can be check or cash only.

Costumes will be distributed June 7<sup>th</sup> through June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2010. Students must be present to receive their costumes. Costumes cannot be returned. If a student's measurements fall between sizes we will order the larger size to ensure that it is not too small. Costumes are not custom fitted and may need to be slightly altered. Once a student receives their costume, they need to put their name in it and keep track of all accessories. Shoes and tights are the student's responsibility-teachers will be providing this information when costumes are distributed.

**Ticket Information:**

All seats are reserved seating. Tickets go on sale on Monday June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at 3:00 pm. Tickets are \$15.00. There are no returns on tickets. Young children under 2 who sit on your lap are not required to have a ticket.

**Photos:**

Jon Ogden Photography has been our photographer for many years and has always done great work. Your picture time will be posted prior to picture day (Sat., June 19<sup>th</sup>). Your entire class will be taking a group picture as well as individual shots.

**Videotaping:**

Videotaping of the recital is permitted.

**Performance Etiquette:**

Dancers **should not** wear their costume to the theatre. It is part of the theater experience to dress at the theater. If you wish to see your child at intermission you must check them out and back in. Remember that we need to know where they are at all times. We need all performers backstage for the grand finale. Please, dancers, **no food or drinks backstage or in the theater.** Water bottles that close would be ideal. Food must be eaten outside.

**Volunteers:**

Each class will need 2 volunteer parents to be chaperones. A Volunteer makes sure that each student is prepared at their performance times, remains with their group and is accounted for at all times, and helps the group line up for the finale. Only volunteer and performers will be allowed backstage. We will also need volunteers for ushering.

**Recital Contract:**

Now that we have discussed the above items please review the attached Recital Contract, Sign and remit with costume payment to the front desk by Monday February 8<sup>th</sup> to avoid late fees (extra shipping charges).
